### ROSHANAK RAHIMIAN AND TEAM AWARDED \$24,000 FOR PROPOSAL

The first round of funding for the internal call for proposals for interdisciplinary research has been awarded to Prof. Roshanak Rahimian and her interdisciplinary team of Profs. Rajul Patel, Nareeta Sharma, Theresa Garner, William Herrin, and Katie Savin. This team will be developing community-based diabetes patient care clinics in high priority areas of South Stockton, in order to further assess the influence of several factors including ethnicity, race, educational and socioeconomic status, disability status, sex, gender identity, and sexual minority status (lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender - LGBT) on the development of prediabetes and diabetes. The goal is to enhance our understanding of the impact of social, environmental and economic conditions within our communities on prediabetes and/or diabetes.
