I enclose you complete statement of the financial condition of the Lydia ore property. It shows a balance of \$6790.28 if this is paid before July 1st then will be \$38⁶⁶ to be deducted. That will leave \$6751.62 still due now of course we would like to have all of this but if Mr Mann will pay \$2751.⁶² it will leave a clear balance of \$4000⁰⁰ against the property which can run for another year or two years if he so desires. I wanted him to have it done before July 1st as I want to go back West by that time and I will have to attend to the matter as my father leaves all of his affairs to me. but he won't allow me to carry it any longer. Now about the Bridge. Waddell says we can't do anything for less than a thousand dollars and I agree with him. it is of the utmost importance that we do this work at once. or we lose our right under our
