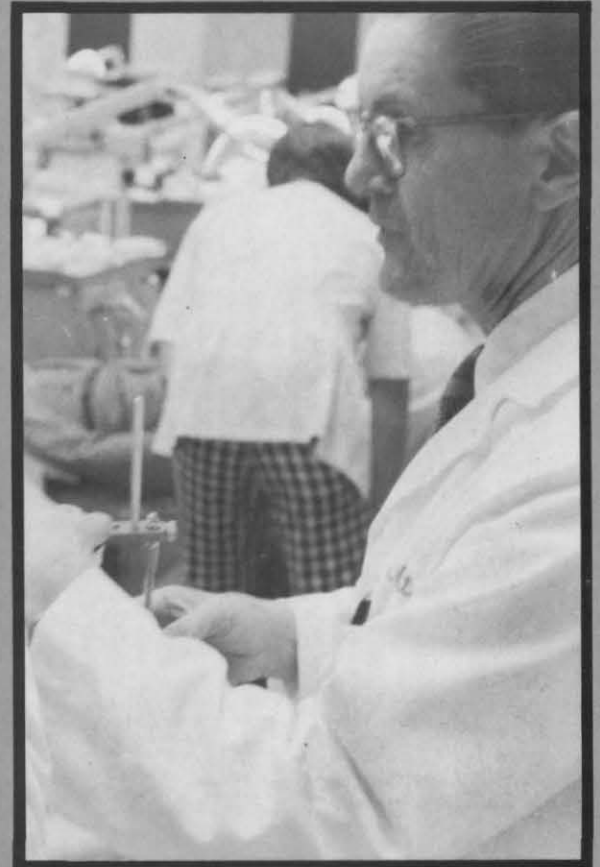


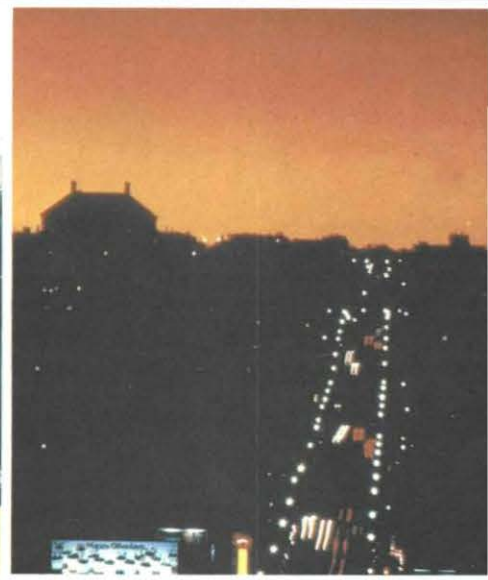


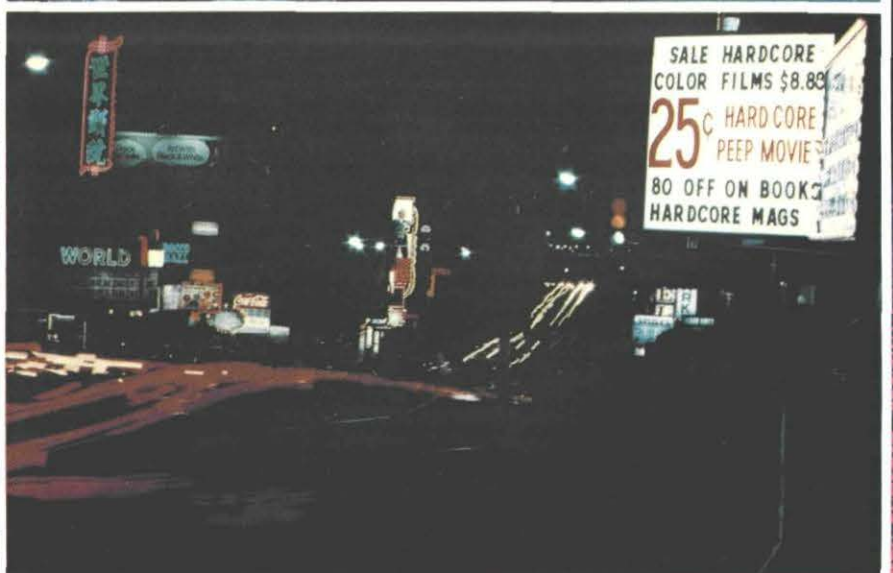
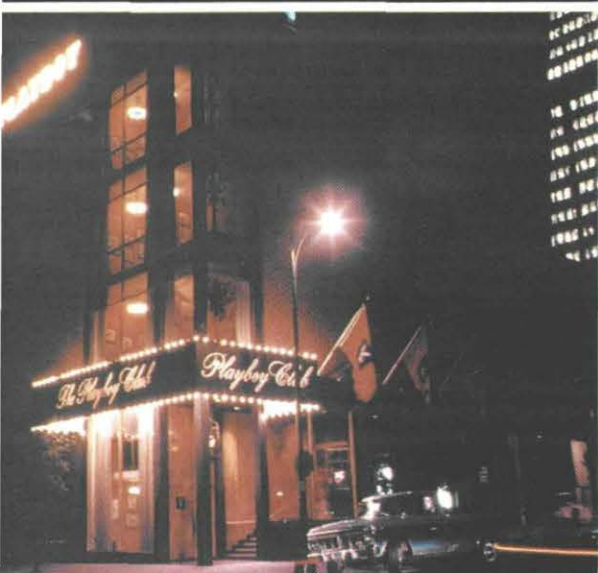
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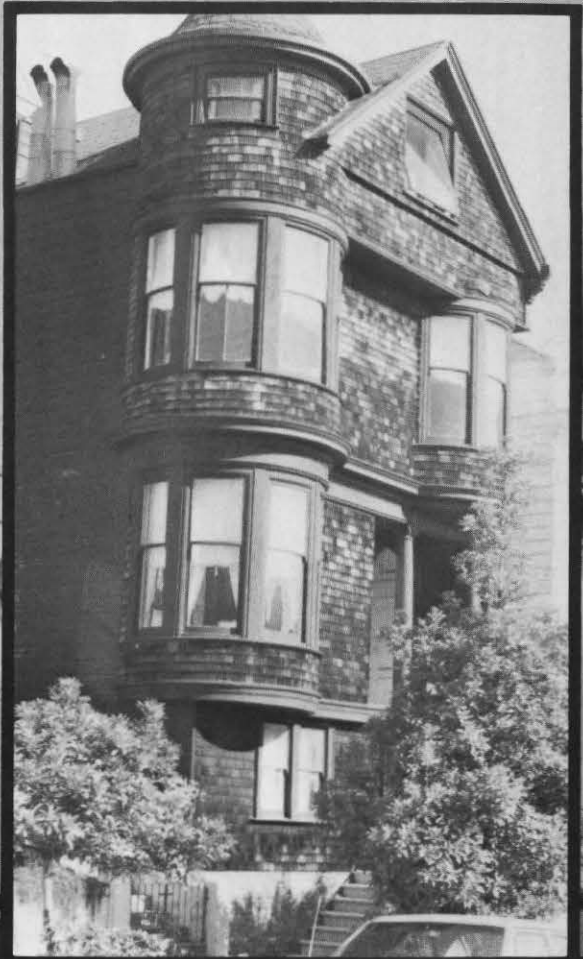
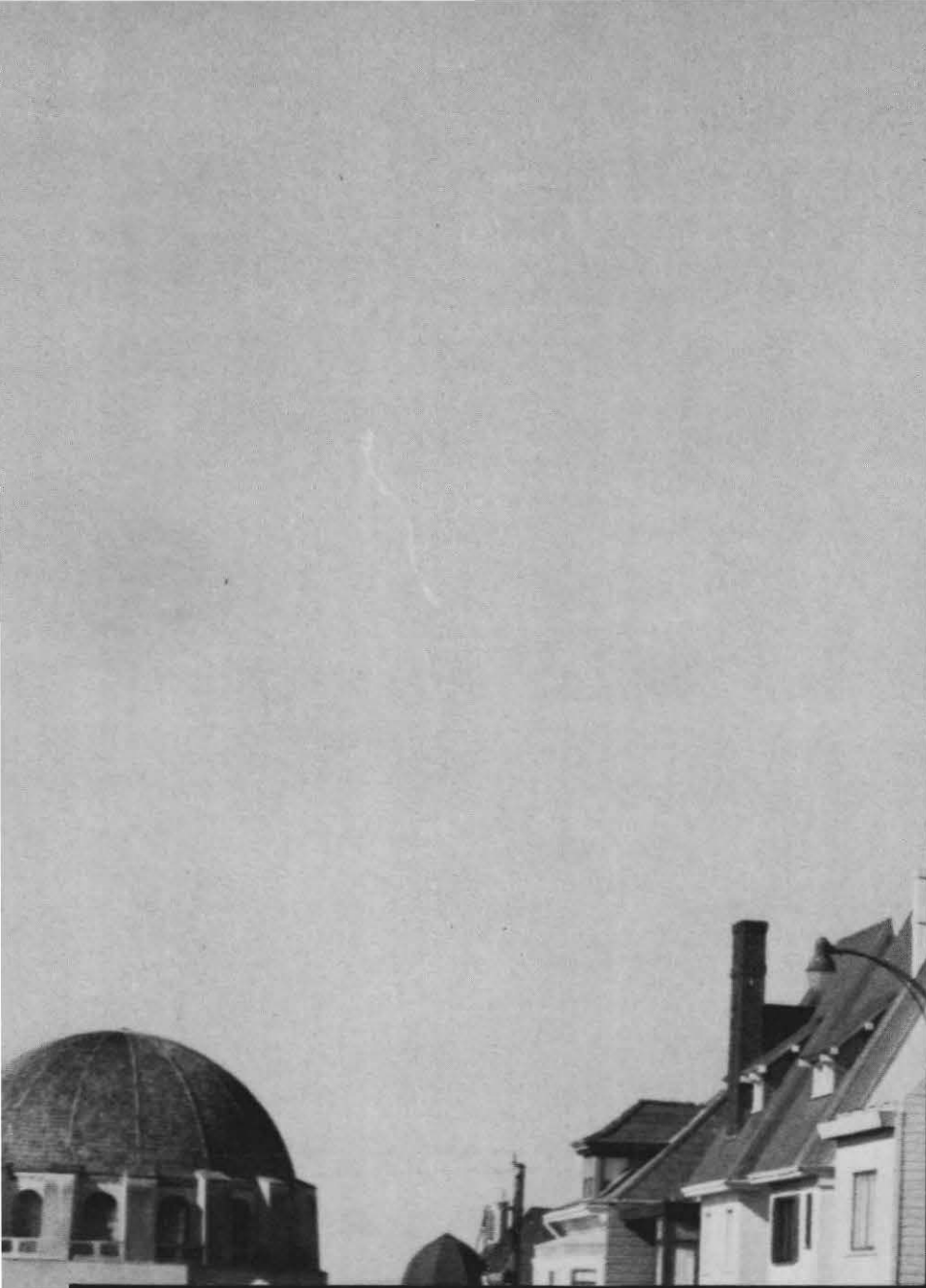
# Dedication '75

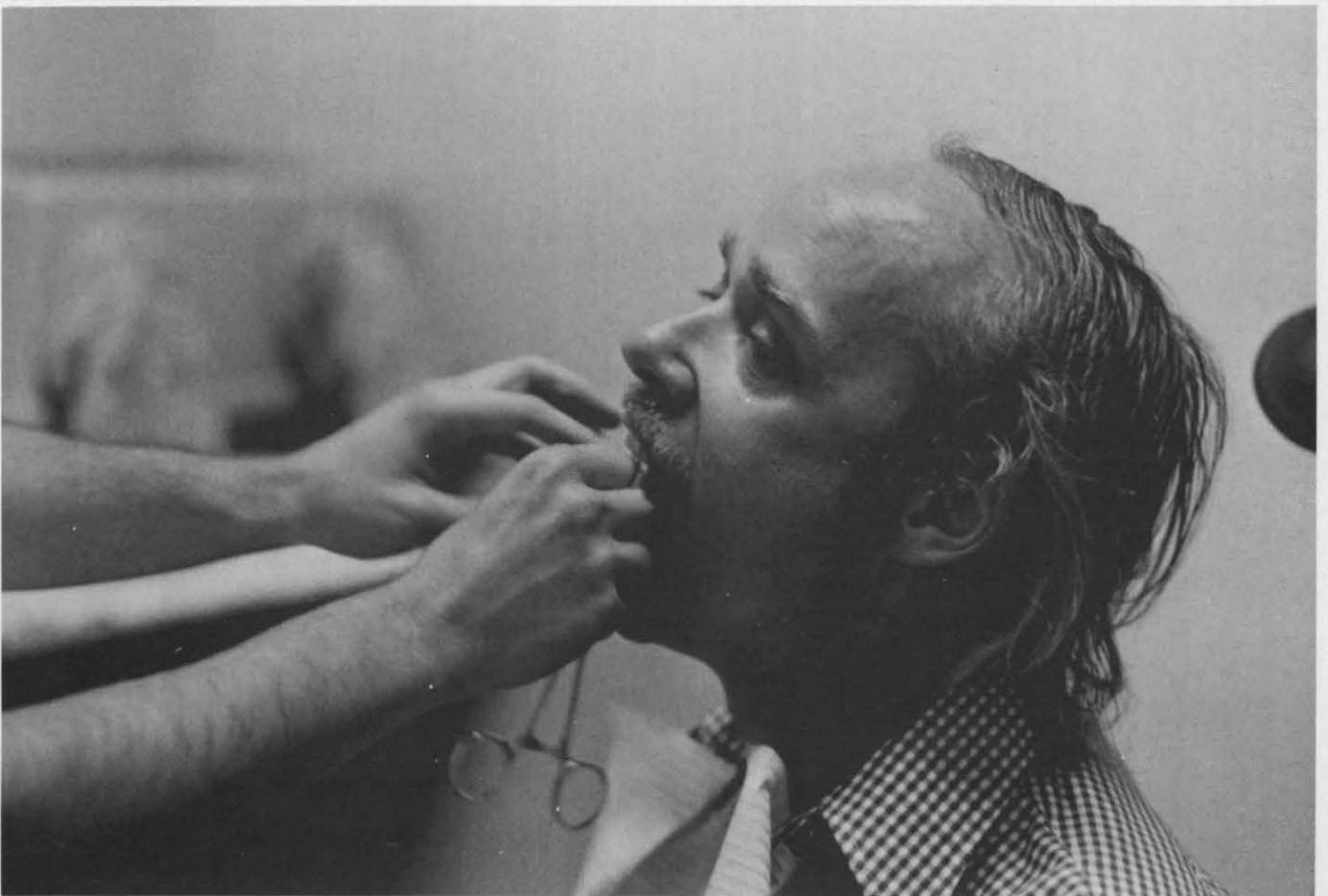
A cock crowed three times and Sir Drillsalot knew the time was 9:30 AM.
