Mokelumne Hill, Oct. 29th 1854

My dear Wife

I write you merely a few lines to inform you of my good health, and that I have written more extensively and sent by Express. In my letter by Express you will find a draft on Adams & Co for \$200. Everything works along with me and my business quite well. I continue to recieve your letters regularly-- I have sent my respects to the friends in my other letter, so they will be obliged to wait a day or two if this one happens to arrive first. I have written a letter to Father by this mail but have neglected to write others. I have nothing especial to write more than I have written in my other letter, and hoping you are in good health I subscribe myself
