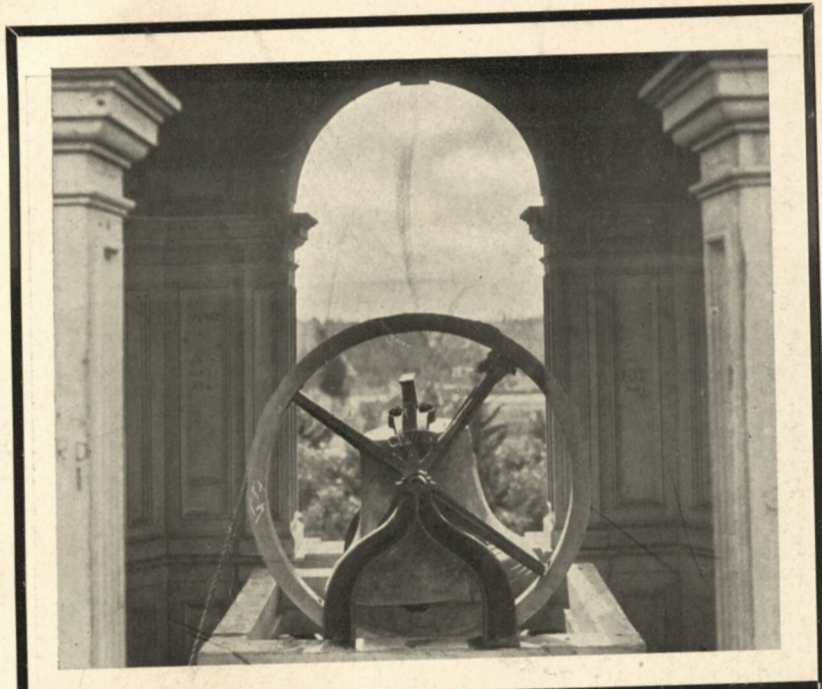

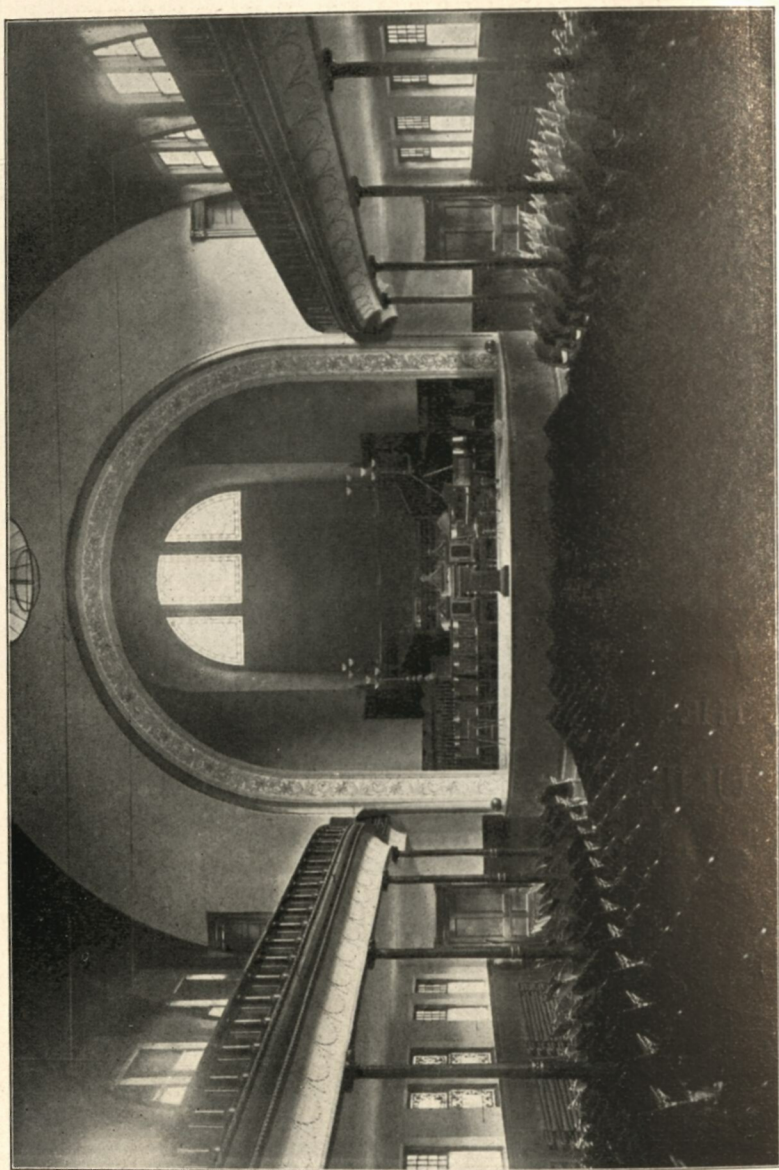

# THE UNIVERSITY OF THE PACIFIC.

SAN JOSE, CAL.

Oldest Co-educational Institution of Higher Learning in California.

Fall Semester Aug. 13 to Dec. 19, 1907. Spring Semester Jan. 7 to May 28, 1908.

## THE COLLEGE OF LIBERAL ARTS.

Curriculum of four years, leading to the Degree of A. B., Ph. B., B. S. or B. L. Fifty scholarships of \$100 a year each, available only for College students rooming and boarding in the institution. Registration fee \$10 a semester. No charge for tuition.

## THE ACADEMY.

High school course of four years, preparing for best colleges. Accredited by University of California. Registration fee \$10 a semester. Tuition \$15.

## THE CONSERVATORY OF MUSIC.

Piano, Voice Culture, Violin, Musical Theory. Four years' course, leading to the Degree of Bachelor of Music. Rooms furnished with pianos for practise. Tuition \$20 to \$80 a semester.

## THE SCHOOL OF ART.

Drawing, Painting in Oil, Water Color and Pastel, China Decoration, Illustration, Composition, Wood Carving, etc. Three years' course, leading to Diploma. Tuition \$15 to \$35 a semester.

## THE COMMERCIAL COLLEGE.

Thorough Business Course, leading to diploma. Bookkeeping, Commercial Law, Business Correspondence, Commercial Arithmetic, Penmanship, Shorthand, Type-writing, etc. Tuition \$37 a semester.

## SCHOOL OF ELOCUTION AND ORATORY.

Two years' course, leading to Diploma. Postgraduate course one year, Teacher's Diploma. Tuition \$40 a semester. Private pupils received.

## PHYSICAL CULTURE CLASSES.

Men's Class meets in the Gymnasium Tuesdays and Fridays, Ladies' Class Mondays and Thursdays. Nominal fee of \$1 a semester.

## BOARD WITH FURNISHED ROOM.

For student rooming with another, \$100 a semester, rooming alone \$115.

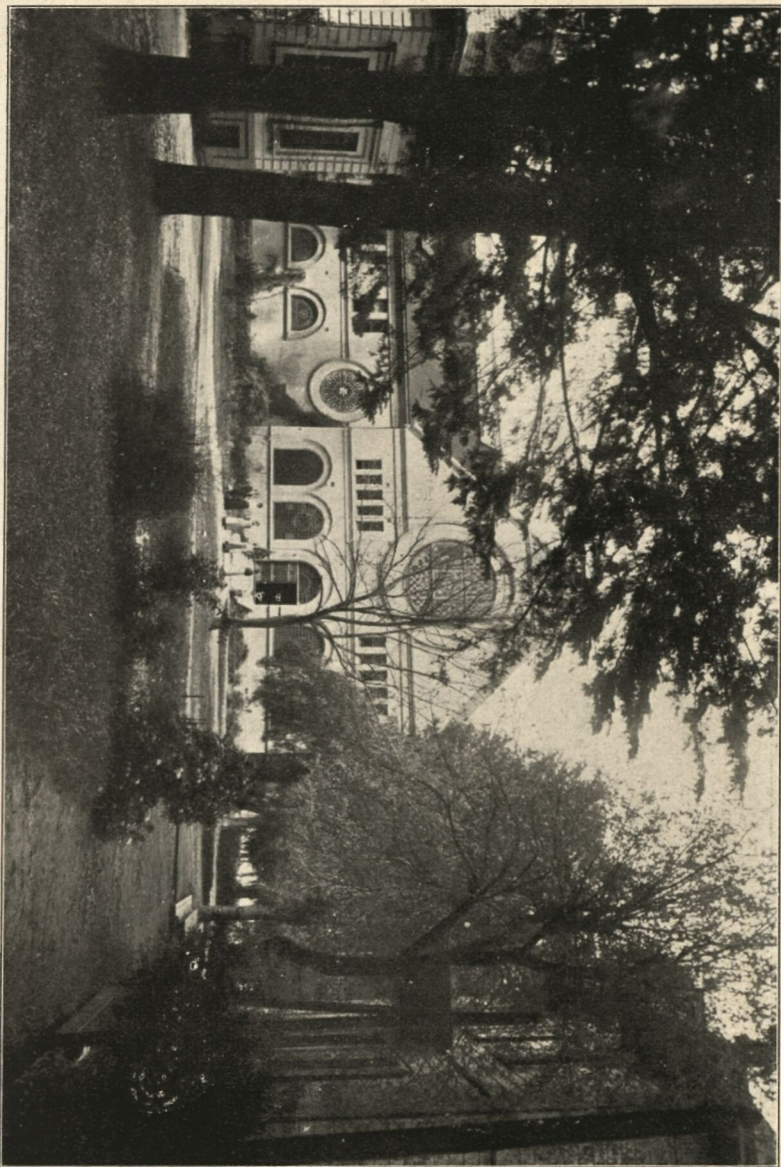

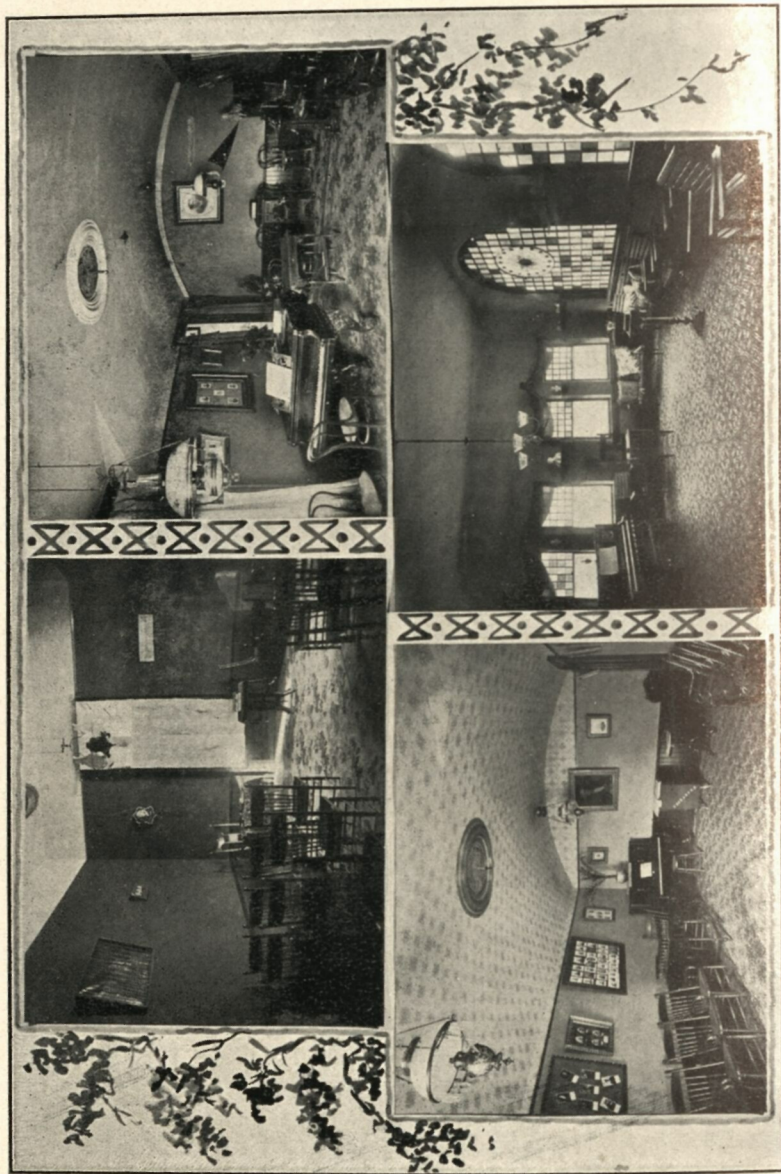

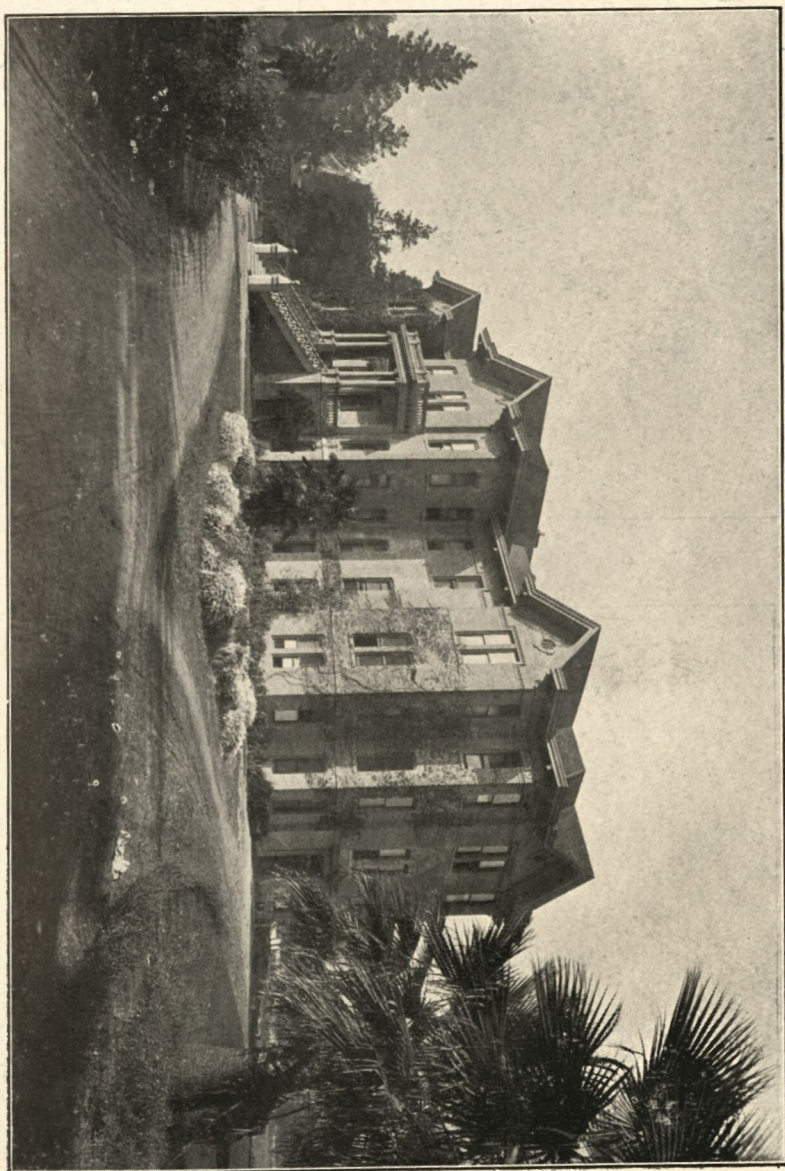

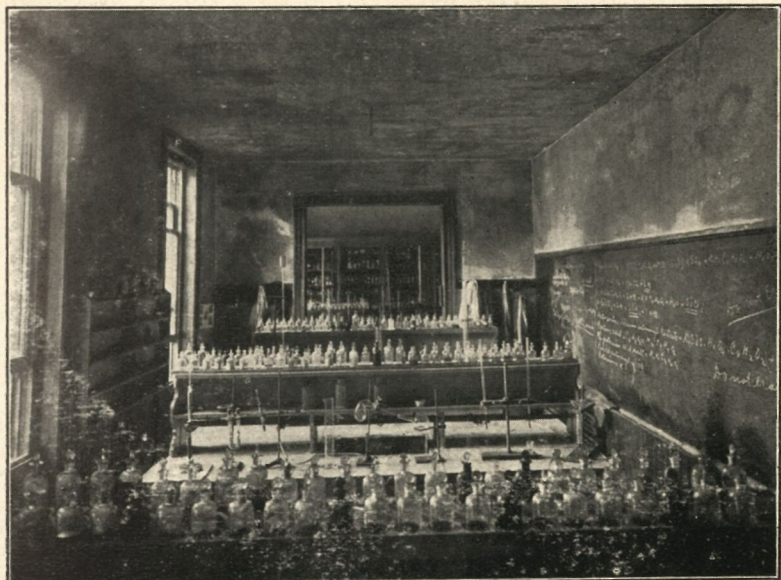

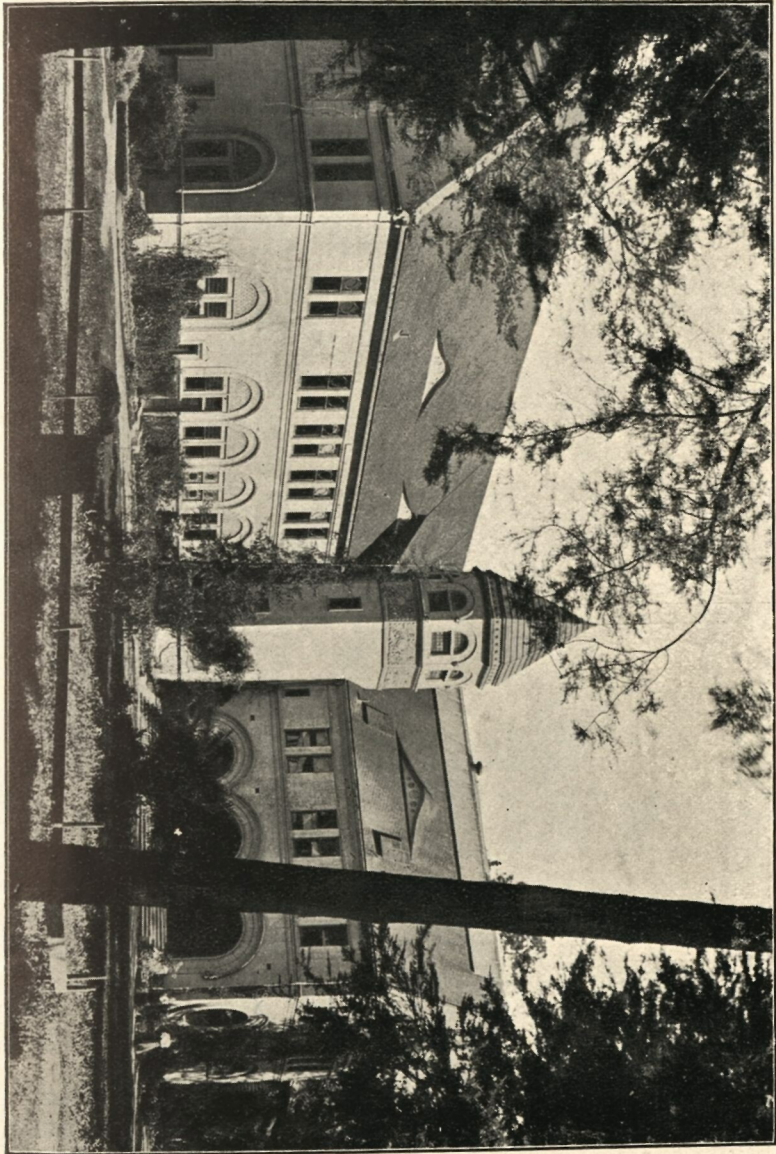

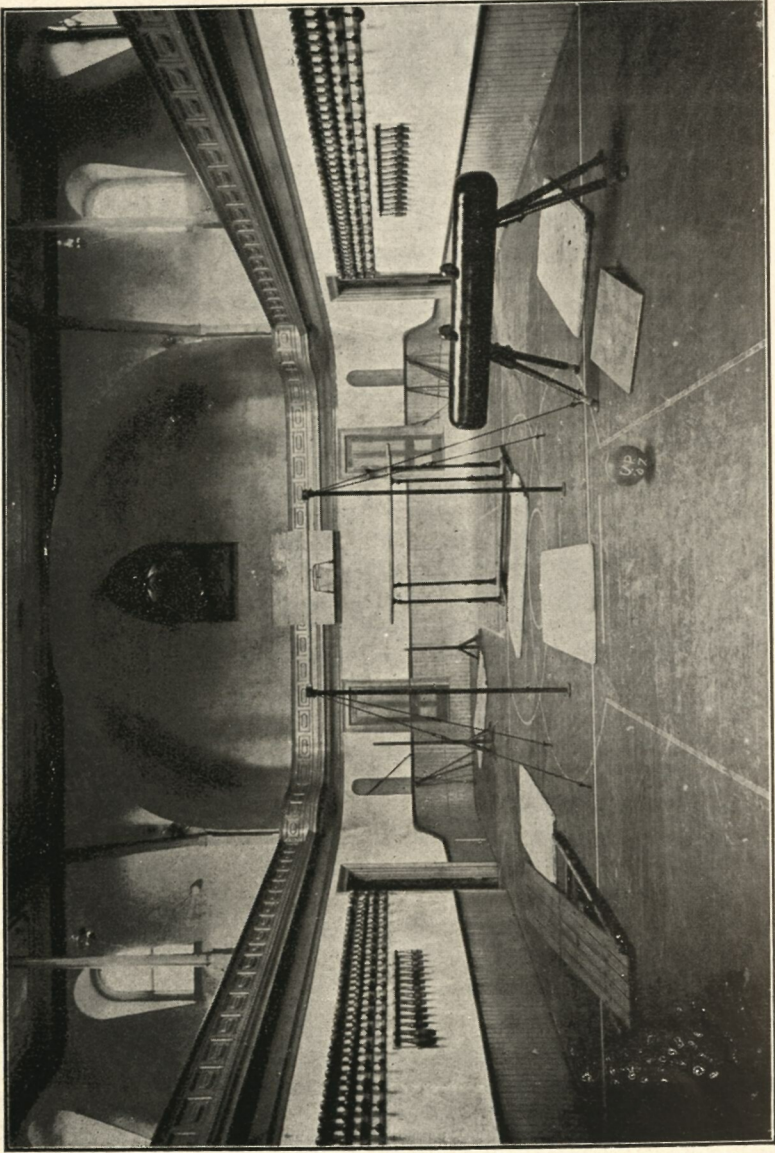
