CURRICULA OF THE SCHOOL OF MUSIC

The Conservatory offers courses leading to the degrees -- Master of Arts, Master of Music, Bachelor of Music, Bachelor of Arts, the general secondary and the special credential in music. The master degrees and the general secondary credential require five years for their completion and the baccalaureate degrees and the special credential, four years.

Master Degrees

The requirements for the degree Master of Arts with a major in music and the general requirements for the degree of Master of Music are found on pages 36 and 37.

The degree, Master of Music, may be granted upon the completion of one years work in residence to students who have received their baccalaureate diplomas from music schools recognized by the National Association of Schools of Music. At least two years, however, must be spent in the study or practice of music between the granting of the bachelor and master degrees.

With composition as a major, the following courses are required:

Composition II (Music 254)	6 - 6

During the year the candidate should submit the following as original work:

- a. A string-quartet in three movements.
- b. A double fugue.
- c. A symphonic poem of at least fifteen minutes duration for full orchestra. This will be regarded as the thesis, a copy of which must be left with the College library before the granting of the degree.

With applied music (except in the field of voice) as a major, the following courses are necessary:

During the year, the candidates should submit the following as original work:

- a. One movement in sonata form.
- b. A fugue in at least three sections showing the usual contrapuntal devices..
- c. Songs and pieces for the instrument in which the candidate is majoring.

d. The scoring of a composition for full orchestra. The composition need not be the candidate's original work but must be a suitable selection from musical literature.

e. Thesis - Theme allied to or in the major subject.

With voice as the major subject:

- a. A cantata for at least four voices.
- b. A fugue of at least three sections.
- c. Several songs.

- b. Continuation of vocal and instrumental study. 2 - 2
- c. Further study of cultural subjects. 3 - 3
- d. Advanced work in general education. 3 - 3
- e. The submission of an original thesis on a topic related to school music. 2 - 2
