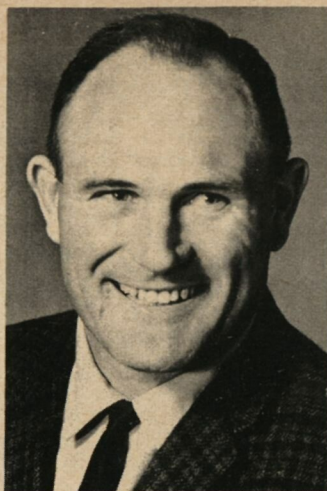

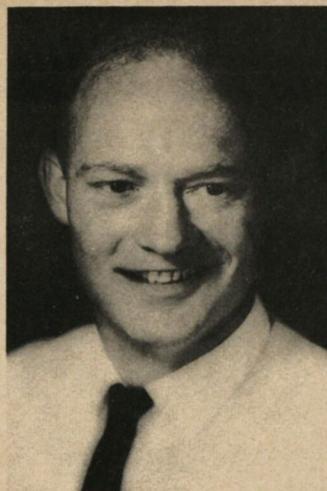

Tiny joins an illustrious and select group of Pacific head coaches, starting with "Swede" Righter in the twenties and followed by the Grand Old Man of Football, Amos Alonzo Stagg, then Larry Simering, Ernie Jorge, Jack Myers and John Rohde.

In 1964 the Tigers will show an improved passing game, using flankers and spread ends running new and exciting pass patterns. With an improved passing attack, the running game should show a marked improvement. At Quarterback Tom Strain is leading the pack, followed closely by Ernie Zermino and Keven Drake. Al Ford, Eddie Simas and Al Melikian have moderate speed and punch. The strong men in the line should be Dick Kirby and Vern Garrison, with Bob Irwin, Paul Latzke, Frank Renzi and Bill Sandeman lending experience and weight to the line.

Assistant Coach Ed Henke brings to Pacific a wealth of defensive experience. Long recognized as an outstanding defensive player in the N.F.L. Ed has been charged with the task of setting up new defenses against both running and passing.

With Smiley Verduzco, John Rodgers, Si Molini and Jack Reed sitting out spring practice, but joining the squad in September, look for the Tigers to be a much more experienced and polished team by the time the Montana U. game rolls around on Sept. 19th.

Today Pacific's young Tigers will meet plenty of Pro Talent in Dick Bass, Duane Putnam, Bob Reed, Bob Denton, Carl Kammerer and many others. So sit back and enjoy the game.....
