AB 552 (Committee on Education); 1987 STAT. Ch 714

(Effective June 22, 1987)

Existing law authorizes the board of trustees of a school district to establish a course of instruction on the human reproductive system, related communicable diseases and sexual responsibility.¹ Additionally, the parent² or guardian³ of each pupil to whom such a course is offered must be given written notice⁴ that the course will be offered and that all instructional materials to be used in the course are available for inspection.⁵ If the parent does not give written consent to the pupil's attendance of such a course, the pupil must be excused from attendance without penalty.⁶ Chapter 714 adds to existing law by requiring the board of trustees to establish a course of factual instruction concerning acquired immune deficiency syndrome.⁷ Chapter 714 mandates the offering of the instruction required by Chapter 714 on or before the first day of the 1987-88 school year.⁸
