Transportation and Motor Vehicles—unlawful sale

Existing law prohibits any person from selling, offering to sell, or displaying for sale any motor vehicle¹ unless the person is (a) the lienholder,² owner³ or registered owner⁴ of the vehicle, (b) a reposessor⁵ or the holder of a statutory lien⁶ selling the vehicle on a bid basis,⁷ or (c) a licensed⁸ manufacturer,⁹ distributor,¹⁰ rebuilder,¹¹ lessor,¹² or dealer.¹³ Furthermore, a violation of existing law is a misdemeanor.¹⁴ Chapter 95 extends existing law to all vehicles,¹⁵ and provides that if the value of the vehicle is \$100 or more, a violation is a felony.¹⁶ If the vehicle is less than \$100, the violation remains a misdemeanor.¹⁷
