Chapter 467 permits county recorders, Nevada Supreme Court justices, district court judges, justices of the peace, and municipal judges to use facsimile signatures.<sup>1</sup> In order to prevent misuse, the facsimile machine must be kept in a vault and must allow for the removal of the signature.<sup>2</sup> The facsimile signature may only be used under the supervision of the officer whose signature is represented and the signature may not be combined with another signature.<sup>3</sup>
