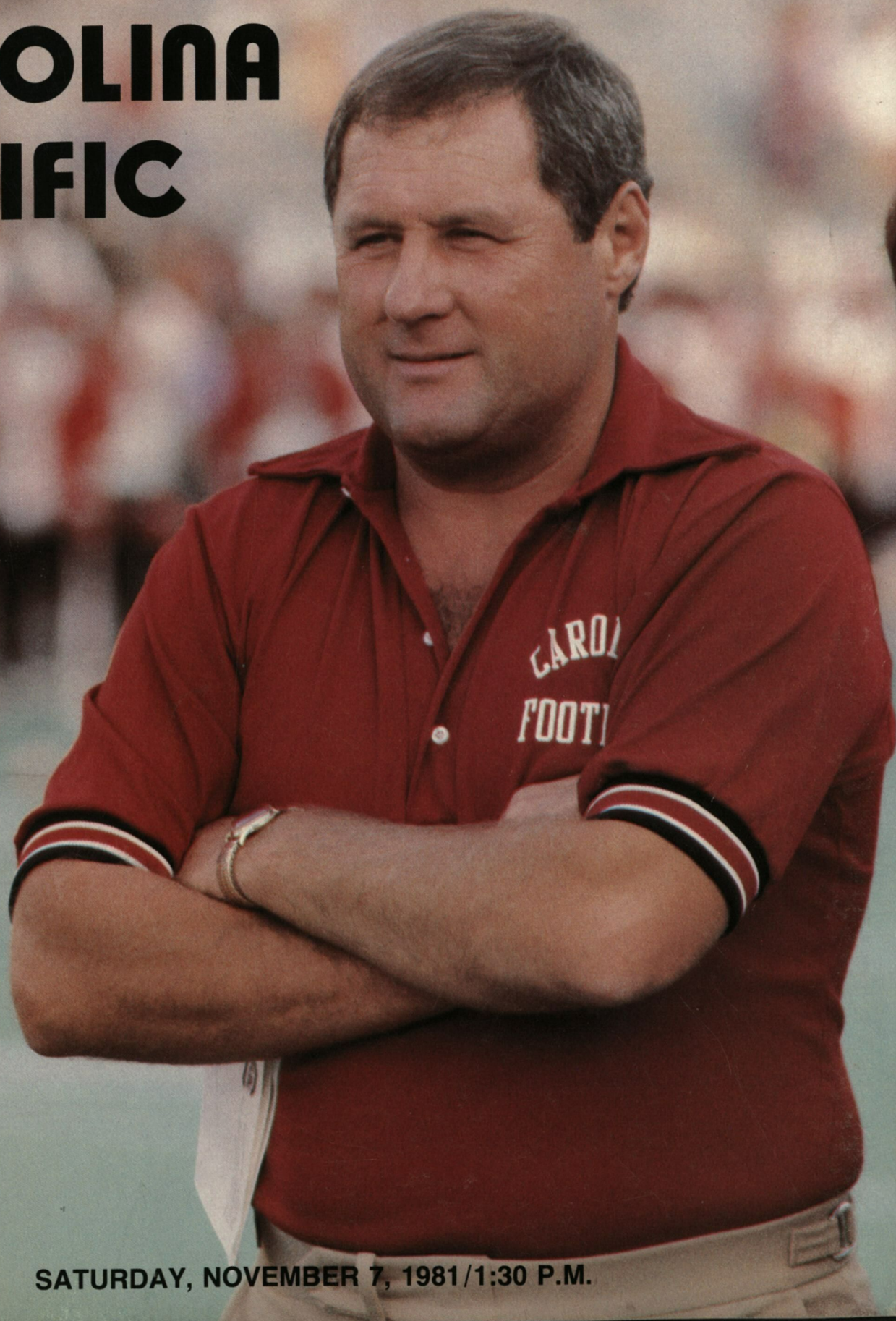

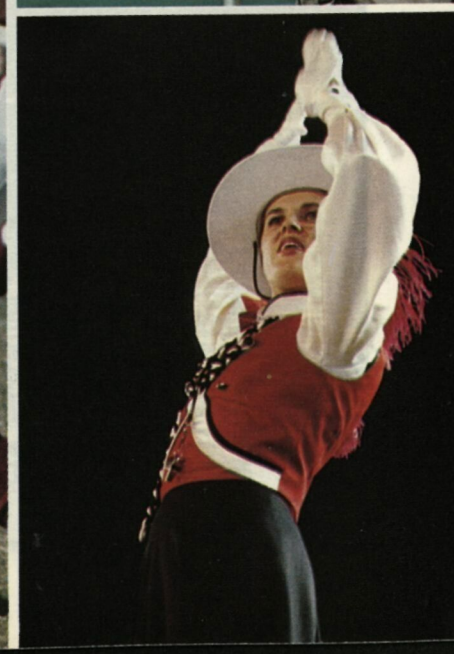

THIS IS CAROLINA

Reminders of a glorious past exist side by side at the University of South Carolina with evidence of a bright present and an even more promising future. The newly renovated antebellum buildings that grace the historic University Horseshoe attest to Carolina's long and heralded past as the nation's first institution of higher learning supported continuously by state funds while nearby, tall, granite and steel highrise structures denote the growth and prosperity that have marked the school's recent history.

Carolina, under the leadership of President James B. Holderman, is a growing university in a growing state — an enviable position in an age when many American colleges and universities are suffering from declining enrollments.

Founded in 1801 and considered for many years to be one of the finest American colleges, USC suffered severely during the Civil War and Reconstruction — first closing for the duration of the war and then experiencing numerous financial and administrative difficulties during Reconstruction.

That lost grandeur has rapidly been reclaimed, however, as the sunbelt and South Carolina in particular have enjoyed rapid economic growth. Along with large investments by American-based corporations, the state has claimed more than \$3 billion in foreign investments. Signs bearing German, British, French, Dutch and other foreign industrial names are a common sight along the state's highways.

The University of South Carolina is keenly aware of how important such investment is to South Carolina, and as the state's largest institution of higher learning, recognizes its responsibility to encourage and foster such growth. To carry out that mission, as well as provide South Carolinians with additional opportunities, the University has worked to establish lasting ties with schools and governments around the globe.

Numerous international visitors have traveled to Carolina during the past few years, including British Foreign Secretary Lord Carrington, West German Chancellor Helmut Schmidt, United Nations Secretary-General Kurt Waldheim and ambassadors from Japan, Yugoslavia, France, Australia and Egypt.

During their visits, most of the dignitaries have toured the new Movietone Exhibit in the James F. Byrnes Center. The display of photographic murals, film footage and videotapes duplicated from the priceless film collection is open weekdays from 10 a.m.-6 p.m. The exhibit is only the beginning of the University's plans for the collection, which was donated to Carolina by Twentieth Century-Fox in the spring of 1980. Using computer and satellite technology, the University plans to make the footage available to scholars around the world, as well as to the interested public.

The Movietone collection contains more than 60 million feet of film, which was taken between 1919 and 1963 by Movietone cameramen who roamed the globe. Supplementing this vast footage is the University's newly acquired Feltner Collection, 2.75 million feet of motion picture film donated to Carolina by movie magnate C. E. Feltner Jr. Among the

footage are scenes of the Spanish-American War, the San Francisco earthquake and captured Japanese film of the bombing of Pearl Harbor. The combination of the Movietone and Feltner footage makes the University the leading repository of historic film footage in the United States.

But Carolina's activities have not been confined to these areas alone. Other research projects have taken USC scientists around the world — from a massive geological expedition to study continental drift in North Africa to a mineralogical hunt in the Sinai, high energy physics research in Germany, hurricane damage control in Central America, studies of the oceanic food chain off the coasts of Brazil and Australia, and a search for lost Shakespearean manuscripts in England.

With a faculty of more than 1,200 and 26,000 undergraduate and graduate students at the Columbia campus alone, USC provides more than 175 programs leading to the doctoral, master's, bachelor's and associate degrees awarded by 17 colleges and schools. Among the programs is the USC School of Medicine, which graduated its first class in the spring of 1981.

Along with the Columbia campus, the University system reaches statewide with other campuses located in eight South Carolina cities. System-wide enrollment is 36,000 and that number is expected to increase at a rate of 4 percent annually through 1985. As well, USC is attracting better students. The upward curve of freshman SAT scores reflects that trend, as does the fact that USC produced both a Rhodes and Truman Scholar last year.

Despite rapid growth, the University has not lost touch with itself or its most immediate constituency — the citizens of South Carolina. USC is heavily involved in local affairs, providing the programs and expertise needed to upgrade the quality of life across the state.

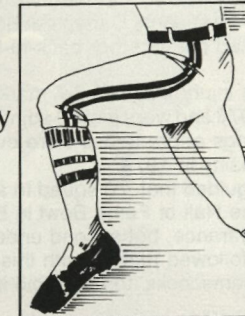
The University expanded its involvement in the cultural arena this fall with the first Carolina Concerts series, featuring such stars as the Cleveland Orchestra and Pittsburgh Ballet. The concerts are in Carolina Coliseum and employ the acoustical shell recently purchased by the University to make the Coliseum an attractive site for major cultural events. Season tickets to the entire series were less than the price of a single performance ticket for most of the groups and the University intentionally kept the prices low so that families could afford and enjoy the series.

Other signs of University concern for its community appear in the form of free tax or legal assistance for indigent citizens, health counseling for the aged, analysis of current social, business, education and economic trends, and tutoring for the mentally and physically handicapped. Other services provided by USC include academic courses beamed statewide via closed-circuit television, art classes for the blind, the Palmetto Poison Center, which provides a toll-free, statewide, poison information hotline, and a host of other services, including nonacademic courses covering everything from belly dancing to smart financial investments.

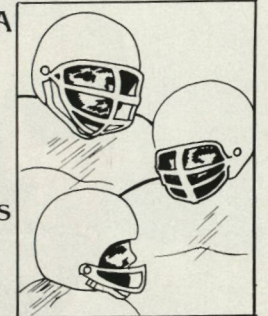

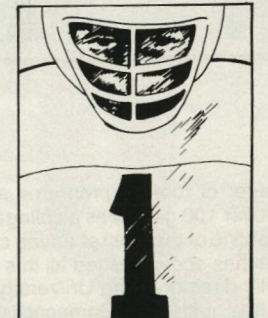
Dick Harris (1969, '70, '71) holds a NCAA record for scoring at least one touchdown on an interception, punt return and kick-off return in a single season in 1970. Harris' record was tied in 1974 by Mike Haynes at Arizona State.



USC tied a NCAA record in 1975 by having 3 players on the same team to each gain more than 1000 yards of total offense in a single season. The players were Kevin Long, Clarence Williams, and Jeff Grantz.



USC holds a NCAA single game total defense record for fewest plays allowed by an opposing offense. The record is 19 plays against Furman on Oct. 1, 1948. (16 rushes and 3 passes for a total of only 10 yards gained by the Paladins.)

JIM CARLEN



Carolina Athletic Director & Head Football Coach

Carlen came to Columbia in January, 1975, as head football coach and associate athletic director. He was later promoted to athletic director in the fall of 1976.

The Gamecocks went 7-4 in Carlen's first year and earned a berth in the Tangerine Bowl, just the third Carolina post-season appearance. The following season, Carlen's squad posted a 6-5 record, the first time Carolina had put together back-to-back winning seasons since 1958-59.

After an injury-plagued 5-7 mark in 1977, the Gamecocks finished 5-5-1 in 1978 and were just 13 points away from a nine-win season. The ear-markings of greatness were evident and "This Is Next Year" became a reality in 1979.

Carlen guided that '79 squad to an 8-3 regular season record and a berth in the Hall of Fame Bowl in Birmingham, Ala., Carolina's fourth bowl appearance, but second under Carlen.

Carlen followed that up with this past season's 8-3 regular season and the Gamecocks' top bowl bid in its history, the 36th annual Gator Bowl.

Carlen has been involved in football for 41 of his 48 years and has been associated with just three losing teams during that span. As a player or coach, he has gone to bowl games 15 times during his 26 years of being involved with collegiate athletics.

Born July 11, 1933, in Cookeville, Tenn., James Anthony Carlen III began his football career with the "Cookeville Killers," a locally organized team at the age of six.

Carlen played four seasons as a standout center and linebacker for Cookeville High under Coach Eddie Watson.

Cookeville was 38-4 during this period and Carlen was selected All-Southern, All-State and his team's Most Valuable Player his senior season.

In addition, Carlen graduated seventh in a high school class of 120.

After being heavily recruited, Carlen enrolled at Georgia Tech in the fall of 1951 to play for Coach Bobby Dodd and study industrial management.

During Carlen's four-year playing career as a linebacker and punter, Georgia Tech compiled an overall record of 40-5-2, including four straight bowl victories.

Carlen's freshman season ended in a 17-14 victory over Baylor in the Orange Bowl, giving Tech an 11-0-1 record. The following year, Carlen and his teammates were undefeated in 12 games, including a 24-7 triumph over Mississippi in the Sugar Bowl.

The Yellow Jackets finished 9-2-1 in 1953 and downed West Virginia 42-19 in the Sugar Bowl. Carlen's senior season concluded with an 8-3 record and a 14-6 win over Arkansas in the Cotton Bowl.

Carlen received his Bachelor of Science degree in Industrial Management in 1955, graduating with a 3.0 grade point average out of a possible 4.0.

After one season as an assistant at Cookeville Central High, in which the team finished 9-1, Carlen spent the next two years, 1956-57, with the United States Air Force in Weisbaden, Germany, obtaining the rank of captain.

Serving as football coach at Weisbaden, Carlen guided his club to a two-year record of 22-2-1 and one European Championship.

Carlen spent the next eight seasons, 1958-65, as an assistant coach at Georgia Tech. While serving as an aide at his alma mater, the Yellow Jackets were 50-31-4 and went to four bowl games.

Carlen was also head freshman coach one season and directed the Baby Jackets to an undefeated season.

In 1966, Carlen accepted the chance to rebuild the West Virginia football program as its head coach. In just four seasons, he elevated the Mountaineers to one of the top powers in the East.

Carlen steadily improved West Virginia and culminated his tenure in 1969 with a 10-1 record and a 14-3 victory over South Carolina in the Peach Bowl.

Moving to Texas Tech in 1970, Carlen produced an 8-3 mark in his first year and took the Red Raiders to the Sun Bowl.

Carlen and his staff rebounded from an off-year in '71 for another 8-3 slate and a trip to the Sun Bowl in 1972.

The next season, Carlen guided Texas Tech to an 11-1 record, including a 28-19 victory over Tennessee in the Gator Bowl. He was selected Southwest Conference Coach of the Year for the second time, NCAA District Seven Coach of the Year and the Fellowship of Christian Athletes Coach of the Year.

In 1974, the Red Raiders were 6-4-1 and were tied by Vanderbilt 6-6 in the Peach Bowl.

A rebuild of football programs at three different institutions, the winner of over 100 games as a college head coach and the mastermind architect of one of the most stunning collegiate football success stories, Jim Carlen has accomplished all this and more as head football coach and athletic director at the University of South Carolina.

Carlen has guided the Gamecocks to back-to-back 8-3 regular season records, the most wins ever by the Gamecocks against an all-collegiate schedule. Under his direction, Carolina has finished the past two seasons ranked nationally and in post-season bowl games.

Regarded among the most successful coaches in the country, Carlen ranks sixth among Division I coaches in terms of longevity and is rated along with the elite of the college coaching profession with a career record of 101-63-6. He has taken teams to post-season bowls eight of the 15 years he has been a head coach, including three of Carolina's five bowl appearances.

Carlen is beginning his 16th season as a head coach on the college level and seventh at Carolina. In that short time in Columbia, he has taken a football program that was a perennial loser and thrust it into national prominence.

Never was that in more evidence than when the Gamecocks beat Rose Bowl-champion Michigan 17-14 before 104,213 fans in Ann Arbor last fall.

Carlen has also proven his ability as an athletic director, as the University's athletic program is one of the most financially solid in the country. He has put much emphasis on hiring young high-caliber coaches and other personnel. He takes a detailed, business-like approach to the department's budget.

Throughout his athletic career, Carlen has received numerous awards and honors, including the Fellowship of Christian Athletes Coach of the Year in 1974, The Order of the Palmetto in 1978 and Churchman Coach of the Year in 1975.

Former Governor James B. Edwards presented Carlen with The Order of the Palmetto, one of the highest awards that can be given a resident of South Carolina.

Active in various charity organizations, the honor came at a roast of the head coach to aid multiple sclerosis, where former President Gerald Ford was among the dignitaries on hand.

He has been actively involved with the Fellowship of Christian Athletes for over 20 years and speaks at many conferences of high school and college athletes.

Before lifting Carolina into national prominence on the gridiron, Carlen rebuilt programs at both West Virginia University and Texas Tech University. He is one of just two head coaches in college football to build winners from losing programs at three different institutions — the other being the legendary Paul "Bear" Bryant.

DR. JAMES B. HOLDERMAN President of the University of South Carolina

Dr. James B. Holderman, 25th President of the University of South Carolina, is vested with the leadership of a system of nine campuses serving 36,000 students and engaged in manifold educational, research and public service activities that touch the lives of people throughout the State. He is the author of the Carolina Plan in which the goals of the University are defined in the context of the unrivaled opportunity for economic expansion and population growth that is the hallmark of South Carolina.

Dr. Holderman was selected President in July 1977 and assumed office September 1, 1977. He and his family, wife Carolyn and daughters Elizabeth, Nancy, and Jamie, moved into the President's home on the horseshoe to open a new era at Carolina.

A widely honored and nationally recognized authority on higher education, Dr. Holderman has received honorary degrees from 11 colleges and universities and has served on the boards of trustees of North Central College and Denison University. He has written numerous articles and papers dealing with higher education and political science. A firm believer that the primary task of a university is instruction, he has taught classes in political science and plans to teach at least one class each academic year.

Dr. Holderman was born in Morris, Illinois, and holds the bachelor of arts degree from Denison University in Granville, Ohio. He earned the doctor of philosophy degree in political science from Northwestern University in Evanston, Illinois. He served as assistant professor of government and public affairs at the University of Illinois, Urbana, and was an assistant

superintendent of public instruction for the State of Illinois. He was associated with the University of Illinois at Chicago Circle in several capacities including administrative assistant to the vice president, assistant to the chancellor, associate chancellor, and vice chancellor. He served as a faculty member in political science through his tenure there.

From 1969-73 Dr. Holderman was executive director of the Board of Higher Education for the State of Illinois, and director of the Health Education Commission of Illinois. As executive director, he was responsible for the state's master plan for higher education, "Phase III for Higher Education in Illinois." In 1973 he accepted a position as vice president for education with the Lilly Endowment, Inc. In that capacity he was responsible for staff direction and accumulative grant allocations for over \$60 million. In 1976 he became a senior vice president and director of Public Policy Programs for the Academy for Educational Development, Inc., a national educational consulting firm.

Among the many appointments, honors and awards he has received are membership on the National Council of Independent Colleges Task Force on Financing of Higher Education, and on the Education Commission of the States Task Force on Statewide Planning, and Task Force on Coordinating Governance and Structure of Post-Secondary Education. He was one of six persons in the nation selected as a Fellow in State Government by the Ford Foundation/Citizenship Clearing House, serving as a special assistant to the governor of Illinois.

Game Day

Gamecocks Look to Extend Win Streak; Pacific Begins Road Trip In Columbia Today

Jim Carlen's University of South Carolina football team, riding a four-game win streak, look to ensure itself of a third straight winning season today when Bob Toledo's Pacific Tigers visit Williams-Brice Stadium for a 1:30 p.m. kickoff.

The Gamecocks, 6-3 on the season, have not recorded three straight winning ledgers since 1932-34.

Carolina, since a spirited comeback in a 42-28 loss to No. 1-ranked Pittsburgh, have

reeled off four straight wins. The Gamecocks have dispatched Kentucky 28-14, Virginia 21-3, nationally ranked North Carolina 31-13 and North Carolina State last week 20-12.

Pacific, though only 3-5 on the year, has split its last four games. The Tigers, of Stockton, Calif., have beaten California-Fullerton 17-16 and Long Beach 17-10 and suffered narrow losses at the hands of Fresno State (30-27) and Utah State (17-14) within the past month. They finish the season with two more road games.

The Gamecocks are also looking to establish some offensive consistency. In wins over N. C. State and Virginia, the attack sputtered, while in the Kentucky and UNC victories, the offense ran smoothly.

Carolina quarterback Gordon Beckham (6-1, 190) will again be at the helm of the Gamecock offense with running backs Johnnie Wright (6-2, 215) and Dominique Blasingame (6-1, 215) behind him.

Beckham has completed 73 of 128 passes (.570) for 898 yards and six touchdowns. His main target has been senior Horace Smith (5-10, 185), who has nabbed 18 for 329 yards and two touchdowns.

Wright is the squad's top rusher with 666 yards rushing on 160 carries, while Blasingame may be the team's top all-around back. He has rushed 52 times for 206 yards and caught 13 passes for 113 yards, to rank third and second on the club, respectively. He is also an excellent blocker.

The Carolina defense, which has been a pillar of strength all year long, is spurred by a tough front five.

Defensive Tackle Andrew Provence (6-3, 260) and middle guard Emanuel Weaver (6-4, 260), both All-America candidates, lead the team in most statistical categories.

Provence has 126 tackles, eight for loss and eight quarterback sacks. Weaver has 107 total hits, including 14 for losses.

Pacific looks to the air for its offense and has a trio of quarterbacks that can get the job done.

Senior Harley Miller (5-11, 179) is the starter. He has completed 73 of 142 passes for 962 yards and four TDs. Sophomore back-up Sander Marker (6-4, 210) has completed 59 of 117 for 572 yards and two scores.

In addition, senior Grayson Rogers (6-4, 215), who threw for over 200 yards against the Gamecocks last year, is also still a member of the quarterback corps.

Flanker Garry Parcells (5-11, 176) is the team's top pass-catcher. Parcells has hauled in 20 for 229 yards and two TDs, but Pacific has eight players with 10 or more receptions compared to the Gamecocks' two.

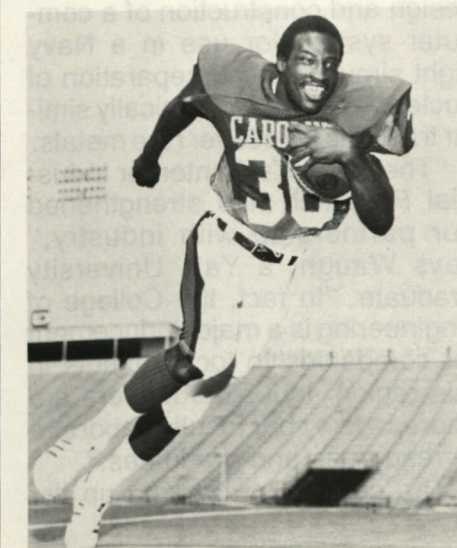

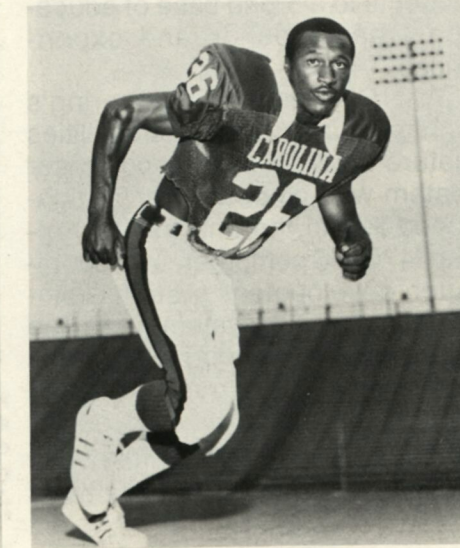

From machine intelligence and computer design to ultrasound testing, the University of South Carolina College of Engineering is on the cutting edge of technology. By addressing practical problems of industry in sophisticated research facilities, the college nurtures its close relationship with industry while providing vast research opportunities for students and professors.

"Our partnership with industry and the Sunbelt's booming industrial development have opened up many new career opportunities for our students," says David Waugh, dean of the College of Engineering. "Our graduates are in great demand, each choosing from about nine job offers with salaries considerably higher than the national average."

"We are proud of the College of Engineering's exceptional faculty, facilities, programs and students. We offer the advanced student the chance to participate in meaningful basic and practical research, the opportunity for close faculty-student contact and the challenge of applying problems of our time."

The faculty of 55 professors has been specially selected from virtually all top-ranking engineering schools in the nation to expose students to a broad base of educational backgrounds and experiences.

The College of Engineering's high technology research facilities feature the VAX-11/780 computer system with color display, a high-speed link to the university's Amdahl 470/V6 computer, microcomputer development systems, single-board trainer systems, and one of the best-equipped high voltage laboratories in the nation.

Additional sophisticated equipment also is available in major research areas such as machine in-

telligence, microwaves, lasers, circuits, electronics, solid state materials, machinery, computer graphics, structures, soils evaluation, dynamics and environmental engineering.

With numerous capabilities and a capacity of more than 100 terminals throughout the college, the VAX system has escalated USC's engineering research to the forefront of national technology in areas such as non-destructive evaluation by ultrasound and light and instrumentation and measurement of stress points in human limbs.

Numerous research projects are underway in the four departments: civil engineering, mechanical engineering, electrical and computer engineering, and chemical engineering. During the 1980-81 academic year, the college's research resources were supplemented with industry and government grants totalling about \$1.7 million.

Among the projects currently in progress are a study funded by the National Science Foundation on effects of earthquakes on the behavior of steel building frames, a combustion project for the Department of Energy Savannah River Plant that involves incineration and disposal of nuclear waste, design and construction of a computer system for use in a Navy flight simulator, and separation of nuclear waste into chemically similar fractions to recover rare metals.

"The college's Center for Industrial Research has strengthened our partnership with industry," says Waugh, a Yale University graduate. "In fact, the College of Engineering is a major inducement for companies to locate plants in this region. Industrial leaders are impressed by our faculty, laboratory resources and graduates."

The curriculum backing up the

research experiences goes beyond bachelor degree programs to master's and doctorate degree programs. The in-depth study required for the master's degree in a specific area gives a sharp focus to the broad engineering background of the bachelor's degree. Additional education to the doctoral level prepares the student who enjoys advanced development, research, or teaching for employment in the most sophisticated laboratories of industry, government or universities.

"Graduate education in engineering at USC involves the student in a balanced program emphasizing either design or research," Waugh explains. "This choice sets us apart from many institutions where the research approach is the only route available to the graduate degree. We recognize that in many cases the professional, non-research master's degree is more valuable to the engineer in industry."

"The increasing importance of doctoral level engineering education is a reflection of the increase in the number of sophisticated industries selecting South Carolina as a location," Waugh says.

Graduate-level engineering courses also are available in locations throughout the state via color video tapes and closed circuit television. This innovative program, called APOGEE, has been studied and copied by other major engineering colleges to enable engineers to continue fulltime employment while working toward an advanced degree or taking courses for career development.

The college strives to provide statewide professional development opportunities to engineers by conducting about 100 workshops a year and offering short courses, many of which are available on

video tape for use at industrial sites.

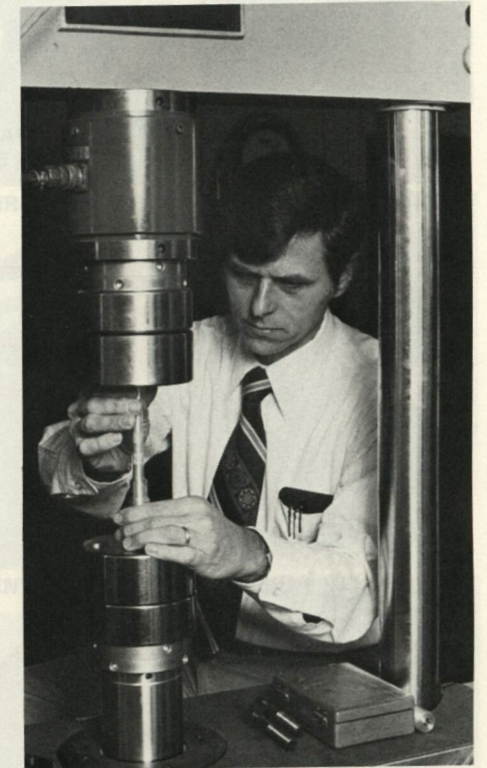
The continuing education offerings are enhanced by the college's membership in the Association for Media-Based Continuing Education for Engineers. Other members include such prestigious institutions as the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, Stanford University, University of Michigan, University of Southern California, Purdue University, and University of Illinois. USC, one of the association's founders, shares resources

with AMCEE members to provide extensive educational programs.

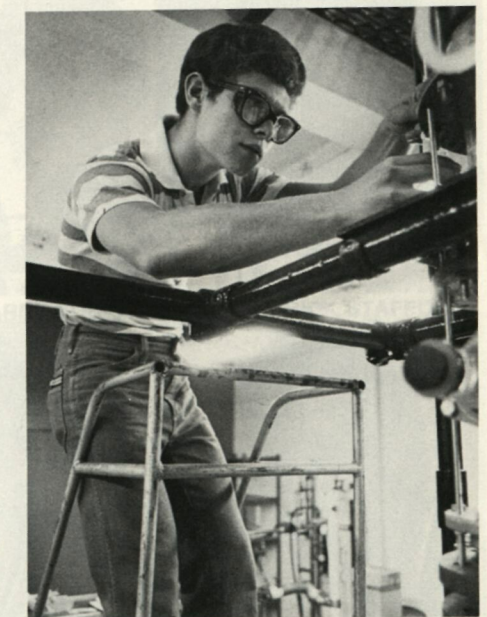

Carolina Swimmers Set To Open 1981-82 Campaign

Carolina head swimming coach Steve Collins won't have to spend much time learning new names this season.

The third-year head coach is in the enviable position of having 12 returnees on the roster for his Lady Gamecocks and 14 swimmers back for his Carolina men's team.

And after two months of preparation, the Lady Gamecocks will get the 1981-82 campaign underway this afternoon at 5 by hosting Miami, Fla., at the Carolina Natatorium. The Carolina men's team will open its season on Nov. 13 when it hosts The Citadel.

The Lady Gamecocks, who finished 15th in the AIAW National Swimming and Diving Championships last year, feature the return of six All-Americans. "There's a lot of quality on our women's team," Collins says. "We're solid and well-balanced all the way, and we have swimmers who've competed on the national level and done well."

The strength of the Carolina women's team could be in the freestyle and individual medley events. Sophomore All-Americans Colleen Collins and Liz Drosdick anchor the freestyle. Collins will swim all the free events from the 100 to distance, while Drosdick will concentrate on the sprint free and middle distance events.

Three All-Americans return in the individual medleys. Juniors Jude DeSando and Sheryl Brosseau both

scored points in the event at the AIAW's last season. They will be helped by sophomore Judi Richardson, who scored in four other championship events in 1981.

Richardson and Brosseau, along with sophomore Mary Vreones, form the strength of Carolina's breaststroke events. Richardson and Brosseau have both been All-Americans in this area.

The Lady Gamecocks' sixth All-American from last season is junior Shelley Cramer. She will aid Carolina in both backstroke and butterfly events. Suzy Reynolds, a school record-holder in the 100 back, also returns.

Junior Kathy McPadden and sophomore Nancy Silvers will handle the diving chores for the Lady Gamecocks this season.

The Gamecocks broke into the ranks of the nation's elite swimming teams last year by scoring at the NCAA Championships in Austin, Tex. And the point, supplied by sophomore All-American Rob Bedford, was enough to rate Carolina the 29th best squad in the nation.

Bedford, along with NCAA qualifiers Paolo Rodeghiero, Greg Werner and Steve Sproule, form the nucleus of what might be Carolina's strongest event, the individual medleys. Collins rates the four swimmers as being of national caliber in either the 200 or 400 IMs.

Another Gamecock strength could

be the sprint freestyle events. Senior E. J. Mercer, junior Jasper Norsted-Jorgensen and sophomores Chris Berry and Greg Salomon are keys in that area. Norsted-Jorgensen and freshmen Leo Girardi and Mark Taylor will bolster the middle distance freestyle races.

Bedford and senior Mark Stover will spark the backstroke heats with depth expected to be added by freshman Dan Hicks. Versatile senior Rick Sawicki adds depth for the Gamecocks in the sprint fly, free and back events.

Two areas concern Collins heading into the 1981-82 campaign, distance freestyle and diving. Hicks, Werner, Girardi and junior Greg Conde will all be expected to help in the distance free. Junior Steve McHenry, sophomore Dave Goldfield and freshman Rob Gentry, a prep school All-American last year, will handle Carolina's diving.

"We have a lot of potential in both areas," Collins says. "But we need to develop some more."

"Both our freestyle and medley relays will be better this year," he adds. "We have more experience in the breast, fly and free, and with Rob Bedford swimming back I feel we'll be able to compete nationally. Last year the strength in these events just wasn't there."

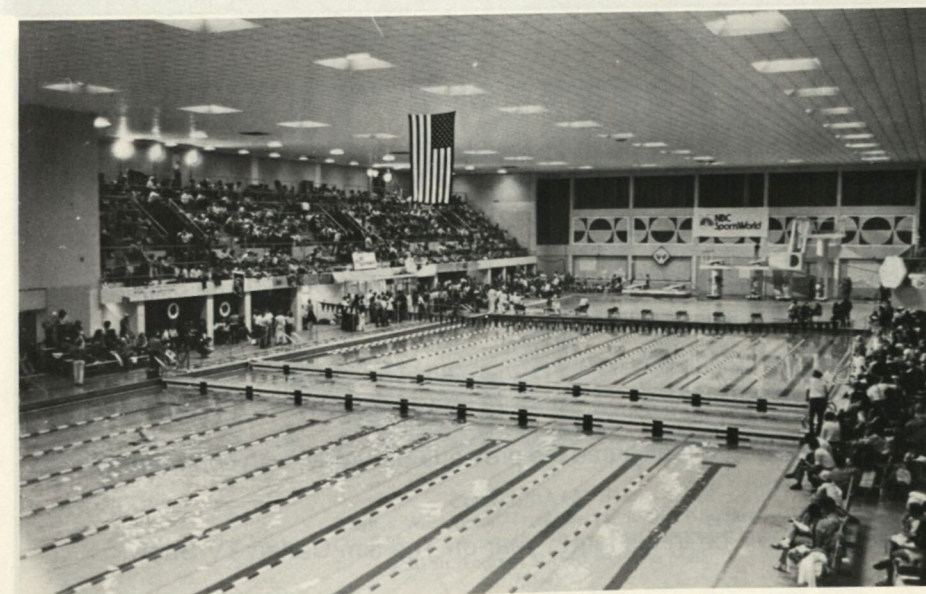

STADIUM GENERAL INFORMATION

Rest Rooms — Rest rooms for men and women are located throughout the stadium on all levels.

Public Address System — The public address system will be used only in case of grave emergency. For emergency announcements go to the first aid station near gate three, gate 11, or near Section 305 and the attendant there will telephone your message to the public address announcer.

Exits — All stadium exits will be opened after the game. Please do not leave the stadium during the game or at halftime if you plan to reenter. No "pass out" tickets will be issued and once a person leaves the stadium he will not be permitted to reenter except in extreme emergency. In such cases go to the press gate on the west side or the pass gate at gate eight on the east side.

Concessions — Concessions are sold at stands throughout the stadium and by salesmen in the stands. Fans are encouraged to come to the concession stands to pick up refreshments for their parties.

Souvenirs — Souvenirs are at two stands by the ramps under the West stands and at various other points in the Stadium.

First Aid — Medical facilities, equipped and staffed as limited first aid treatment stations, are located for convenient access in all stadium areas. If assistance is needed, contact the nearest usher for directions to the nearest first aid facility.

Drive Carefully — Upon leaving the stadium we ask your full cooperation with the highway patrol in the effort to speed the flow of traffic from

the stadium. And, on the way home, please drive carefully as the highways will be congested with weekend crowds.

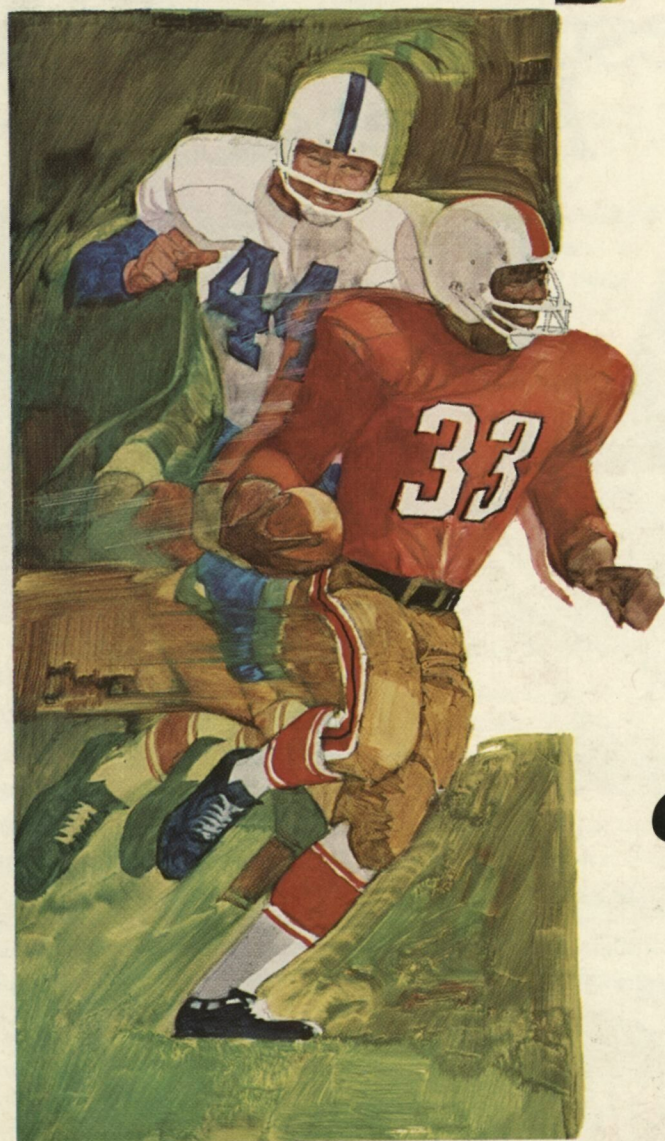
