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# Introduction

Herein the Pacific Law Journal presents its third annual Review of Selected California Legislation. The Review is intended to provide a concise, practical analysis of 1972 legislation of particular significance to the legal community and is designed to identify what the new law is or will be upon the effective date of the legislation, the background or prior law, and the legislative intent and objectives behind introduction and enactment.

The legislation contained in this review is organized topically under twenty titles listed in the Table of Contents. In this regard it may be noted that the scope of review has been expanded to include coverage of the education and elections areas. A Table of Code Sections Affected appears at the end of the review to enable the reader to locate changes discussed with respect to particular code sections.
