Port Townsend April 20th 1859
On Board Str. "Favorite"

Dear Mr. Muir

We are at last on our way north with the Str. Favorite and hope to reach Wrangell in about five days. We got the new tonnage measurement today from the custom house, it is 85 tons, the accommodations are fine and the boat is well arranged and fitted up, we have her full of freight & fuel. Now you must come up this summer and spend the season with us, we will take good care of you.

My wife and children are in good health and will go to Wrangell on the Mary California to remain with Mr McWholms some of the time in Sitka as I expect to remain there some of the season. With sincere regards hoping that you will come I remain
