My Dear Sir

I hope to be in Martinez between Christmas and New Years, and if you can have it ready by that time I shall be under many obligations. Don't forget to copy some of your glacier sketches, as many as you can spare, and some sketches of the plants also.

I have heard nothing from my application to go to Greenland but see by this morning's paper that Genl Hagen says three staunch vessels will be sent. Possibly one of them may be a revenue cutter.
