502 Oct 21 th 1860 Down John We have received three letters from you two from Madison and one from Prairie du Chien, we were glad to know your houth was with with good, in the midst of so much iscutement and praise I hope you find yourself comportable in your new home, and likely to learn some of Those Things you want to know, I am glad you found so many priendo at Madison und hope you will find friends where ver you go _ We were rather surprised to know that you had set your fuce westward, and so is every one that hears of it - how ever I hope that will those out for your good - I always under -stood that Prairie du Chim was and unheatthy place but perhaps it is healthy in Wanter your Father went down to Portuge on Friday The 19th and bought a trunk for you and a suit of blothers and a hat une three pair of Socks and a pair of drawers - and I sent three fine shirts and two common ones and your flannel shirt and your pupers and letters and small books your Father put them all in the trunth together at Portage and then put The Key in a paper and tooth it to the Post affue I have been particular in telling you -

Non John I hope you will write as soon as your trunk comes to hame as I um unscious to throw That you have received it safe, I hope every thing will suit you, your Father intended to send a sille naphin for your nech but forgot until the key was sent off , let in know how much the Carriage of the truth cost you let no know how many churches there is in Praire Mulhury and which you attend and if there is any Sunday Schools and let us know how you are getting on -There is a prayer meeting every Sunday night at midland School and is pretty well attended I internet to owno this letter with them to high the all join in love to your hoping your hutth improves - from your affectionate
