Town of Buffalo, th Sept 1861

Dear Child

I have sent you inclosed ten dollars it is all I can spare just now let me know when you are in great need & I shall again try, to give you more I have seen some mistakes since you went away & have put them right I have put 5 1/2 days more ^{of grubbing it up} to J. H. Jacobs acct which amounts to 4 1/2 Cents. and the same to Davids with 484 Cents besides which his grand father gave him when he left Dunbar: if I have before ~~credited~~ it in to his other monies let him say so when he writes, we are all well & busy getting in the wheat seed I have nothing new to write I hope you will get the money safe, let me know about it as soon as you get it your mother hopes you got safe to Madison with all your things, be sure & please your Heavenly Father by believing his every word & keep his commandments

P.S. David I had carried your account to a new place in my book where the price of your share \$8.00 was marked along with the other so that is something more still.
