Dear Friend;

Although not particularly invited to participate in the correspondence, which is carried on between you and the children, I hope you will excuse the liberty I take in so doing; for I feel that I owe you an apology, for my negligence in fulfilling your request at the time I certainly intended doing so, but in laying it away safely until the time should come, for me to send it, I laid it away so securely, that it
