L'inclose this bripple us a birth day present - Mingt hus not got home get but she much better 12 um glad prient to visit with his new home and was much plans with the appearance of the farm I think it is a very pleasant filure und only about 8 miles from Portage they have a large fine orchwid with the appearance of filenty pruit of different Kinels they have a good school and a public road to it we are all well. The girls still attend school how Duniel I hope you well write when you receive this und. let us know when you had a letter from John from your ever affectionate mother
