Dear Daniel

I begin to think you are very long in answering my last letter so I write again. I want to know how you are getting along the path of life - are you still in the same shop - have you decided to come west this summer you know I am always glad to have you come - I hope you are as much interested about religious matters as before - as spiritual things are of so much greater importance than temporal concerns are - We did not forget your birthday last Friday hoping you will yet see many happy returns of it.

I enclose this trifle as a  
birth day present — Mary has  
not got home yet but she  
is much better, I was glad  
of it. a few days ago we  
went to visit <sup>swank</sup> at her new  
home and was much pleased  
with the appearance of the  
farm I think it is a very  
pleasant place — and only about  
8 miles from Postage they  
have a large fine orchard  
with the appearance of plenty  
fruit of different kinds  
they have a good school and  
a public road to it —  
we are all well. The girls  
still attend school —  
now Daniel I hope you will  
write when you receive this  
and let us know when you  
have a letter from John
