Farm April 15<sup>th</sup> 1867

Dear Daniel

I received your letter from Indianapolis and am thankful to you for your kindness in visiting John in the time of his distress. I am sure he would be glad to see you and have one of the family with him for a while. In his last letter to me he says he intends to go to the shop again very soon — I hope you are well and comfortable — the girls went to the examination of teachers at Montello — and they were examined and all of them have got certificates to teach — Mary is engaged to teach in Sutfins district three months beginning in May — and Anne intends to teach too — the examination of teachers



at Portage commences tomorrow and the girls are  
all going there to be examined again —  
Margt went back to the water cure last week  
and Jessie has come back to stay with us —  
Charles Meil has been at the water cure for some  
time and he thinks he is gaining some — his  
health has been very poor for a long while —  
along with this the girls send you a <sup>newspaper</sup> ~~newspaper~~  
written by the students of the high school, they  
thought you would know some of ~~them~~

I really hope no accident will befall  
you — may you be guided and guarded  
continually by grace divine —

John has decided not to come home at this time  
but we will be glad to see either of you at  
any time — write soon from
