two of Goldkoste. To attend

the High School -

So we have
been here over a week
the house seems very large
for us two - but it
reminds me very much
of our old home across
the ocean - although it
is not as large -

We would
be very much pleased
to have you both here
when you can make
it convenient -

David has not been very
well for some time, but
feels a little better now -

Last week he had
another baby boy added
to his family -

There
were a fair held in
portage last week - and
Sarah brought in her
white bed spread, and
her colored mat - Emma
perhaps you have seen
them, they were very
