got home yet but we expect

Sarah had a
letter from John yesterday
dated June 7th he had just
returned from visiting -
Mount Lyell and Mount Dana
and had camped out
on snow 5 feet deep
but a few hours of

travel brought him to
plants and flowers and
sunshine - he got his
face badly scorched by
the sun on the glacier

has transpired about us
leaving Portage - only
we hear a great deal
about California lately
but our home here is very
comfortable -
