Dear Louie. The funeral was on Thursday & I should have been on the way for home by this time but Anna is sick & says she will not be able to leave here before Wednesday 14th. You need not in any case telegraph to Walter as I shall give you notice when we start & when we are to reach Martiney - David & Mary have gone home. So have Maggie & Frank. Dan did not come to the funeral & Mother telegraphed she could not come. When Anna & I leave for Joanna will be alone once more after all this. She is pretty well tired out. I have seen a good deal of David, & miss him much now that he is gone.

I think Anna will stand the journey pretty well. Dan says that she is likely to get entirely well with proper care. We connect with the Southern Pacific at Mojave & I will telegraph you there within a day of home. Sorry to be delayed again after all your waiting. But I cannot leave Anna though she says she can follow alone.
