Dear Brother,

I have just come home from Milwaukee
this whom I have been for the past two weeks
(about), just before I went off I got a letter
from David saying that he thought that
they would send two thousand dollars down
to invest here for him and one Wright some
time in Feb'y so I have held your money from
investment until I heard definitely from him
which I hope will be ere long.

I will write you as often as any good word
is known. The 17 acres we bought 50 days
since is the cheapest of any ground in that
locality at 3000. \$ per acre, we paid 2000. \$ per
acre. I hope you got the paper and plat of
the City which I sent you. I feel not our very
well and happy. Grandma is doing famously with
the book of Childs stories which she is working upon,
some of the eight or ten completed runs very smoothly
and easily all their length thro'.
