DEAR Brother

Herewith I hand you a trust
Deed from you to Paul H. Corder with
Judge J. H. Austin as Trustee. The Laws of
Missouri require this sort of a Trust
Deed in place of a mortgage. Please sign
the deed in presence of a Notary
Public (the wife's signature is not required)
and sign the notes and have them all
sent back as soon as possible to me.
Then in case the title proves bad I
will cancel them and return them
to you. Judge Austin is a personal
friend of mine and is an honest
man, but if he were not if you
pay the notes he has no chance to do
harm. I shall send you the Warranty
Deed as soon as the papers are examined
and I get the Deed of Trust back from
