Dear Wanda we are just leaving the
Boston Station for N Carolina.
At Wilmington we will pick up
Carly & go right on. At New
York we have to change Cars &
wait 2 hours. & expect to meet
Johnson to whom we have telegraphed
I have not felt well for a few days
so stopped over yesterday at Sargent
for plan at Brookline. We telegraphed
Page & he came out to lunch
& stayed 2 hrs. - he is a really
pleasant fellow.

The horrible food & eternal jolting
& carbonic acid upset my
stomach. & it is slow about
getting steady again.
Sargent wants me to stop till
Christmas.

Fair to find Johnson
so gliding through New Jersey
getting dark. Baltimore at
9.30. Washington 10.30.
& to bed feeling better

in Virginia beautiful leafy
hills & dates just beginning
