My dear Sellers.

I am glad you have weathered the storm & I devoutly hope that soon you will be perfectly free from pain & sound & strong as ever.

I have always felt that sidewalks & every thing artificial & civilized were dangerous & this dreadful accident is surely enough to drive you into the wilderness. Providence has to all but kill us <sup>to get us</sup> into safety.

It is growing late & it behooves  
us to be up & away on our  
mountain tramps while the light

on the continent. In the mean-  
time "for a' that & a' that" I wish  
you a happy New Year, all  
three, with good living grants  
for your feet.
