Dear Sir

Did Mr Quill make satisfactory arrangements with you for that piece of land back of his place. I notice this morning that he has it graded with the intention of improving it. I should think he has between 50 & 60 ft.

There is a man here that wants to buy the property of Mr Gales which is on the ranch near Valma. but wants to know if you would give him a lease for 5 years provided he paid his rent on time. I told him that if you said he could have it for that time that would be as good as a lease.

I understand that Mr Gibbon has turned his stock over to the board or his creditors. & gave an account of 75⁰⁰/₁₀₀ for rent due. Will you advise me what to do about his rent. he owes to Nov 1st 04 \$120⁰⁰/₁₀₀.
