Dear Sir:-

We wish to insert a sketch of your life in the National Cyclo-
pedia of American Biography, a work now in preparation, which will
be to this country what the great National Biographies are to Europe.
Will you therefore kindly have a biography prepared, or furnish me
the data, together with brief mention of your ancestry, to enable me
to write a proper article.

The Publishers make no charge whatever for the preparation
and insertion of this sketch; neither is it obligatory to take a
copy of the work, though of course they will appreciate the sympathy
and support of such a subscription.

The press has endorsed this work as the biographical author-
ity of the century, surpassing everything of the kind ever pub-
lished. It will be sold by subscription, but is not yet placed upon
the market, though nearly 5,000 advance orders have been given,
