Bro John

To speak of paying you any money in ~~my~~ present financial embarrassment is entirely hopeless.

When you were here you offered to assume an incumbrance of \$3000. on my home premises and give me \$500. and your account against me for a deed of same.

The present incumbrance is \$4300. Now if you will take care of that and give me \$500. and your account I will give you a deed to my home premises and to 160 acres of land within 2 1/2 miles of Lodge Pole a fine village on the U.P.R.R. in in
