Did you get to the glaciers last summer and have you any information for my annual report on the variations?

I spent the summer in the Alps with my family and did more climbing than glacial study. We were in the Dolomites which have some wonderful and beautiful forms and which carry very little ice. I was also in the Engadine and there had a meeting of a number of European glacialists, who accompanied me to the Forno glacier and were convinced of my views regarding the relation of stratification and blue-bands.
