At May's. Friday Morning
Dec. 24. 1908

Darlings I got home last evening instead of Wednesday evening - a whole day late. Our train was 11 hrs late at Barstow & passed Muir at 3 or 4 o'clock Thursday morning, so I went on to Richmond. Slept until the Porter woke me at 7.25 to take the boat for San Francisco where I spent the day. & came back on the 4 o'clock train. There was no frost or snow beyond Williams & all hereabouts seems a new heavens & earth strangely tropical but less beautiful than the white Adarrana world. Be sure you get your bedding dry & keep well, I'm going back to the City today & to Valona tomorrow. Will write the news in day or two. Heaven bless you darlings -
