EXPERT ENGINEER WILL
SPEAK ON HETCH HETCHY.

BERKELEY, November 6.—Marsden Manson, the noted expert on water supplies and former chief engineer for the Spring Valley Water Company, has been invited to speak on the subject of the Hetch Hetchy valley water project at a banquet to be held November 21st by the North Berkeley Improvement Club. Manson has been investigating the plan to supply the bay cities from this source and recently made a trip to the Hetch Hetchy valley to familiarize himself with the ground. He is said to be enthusiastic for the proposition. This is the first formal banquet to be given by an improvement club of Berkeley. Final arrangements for the affair will be made at the meeting of the club to-night.
