I enclose Clearing House Certificate  
and checks to the amount of  $\$194\frac{99}{100}$  to be  
credit as follows

X To Mr J. E. Petersen on note created 50<sup>00</sup>  
In your account of principal only \$25

" " Mr. Arbick on lots 35<sup>00</sup>

" " J. Palken .. lot. 10<sup>00</sup>

" " John Bonacci on lot 2 B. 33 100<sup>00</sup>

The balance  $\$250\frac{00}{100}$  he is to pay at 195  
 $\$25\frac{00}{100}$  per month. The price of lot 2 B. =  
33 was  $\$350\frac{00}{100}$ .

Mr Lucey who owned lot 1 B. 33  
wants lot 8 B. 33. I told him it was  $\$350\frac{00}{100}$   
he wants to pay 75<sup>00</sup> down & 20<sup>00</sup> per month  
(I think he ought to pay 100<sup>00</sup> down & 25<sup>00</sup> per month)
