Friday June 6, 1913

The grew on the three trees of my little ranch. Tom says he is going to send you box also.

I've forgotten whether or not I told you of the Honorary L.L.D. the University of California gave me last Commencement. I must have looked grand & heroic in my academic robes in the Greek Theater.
