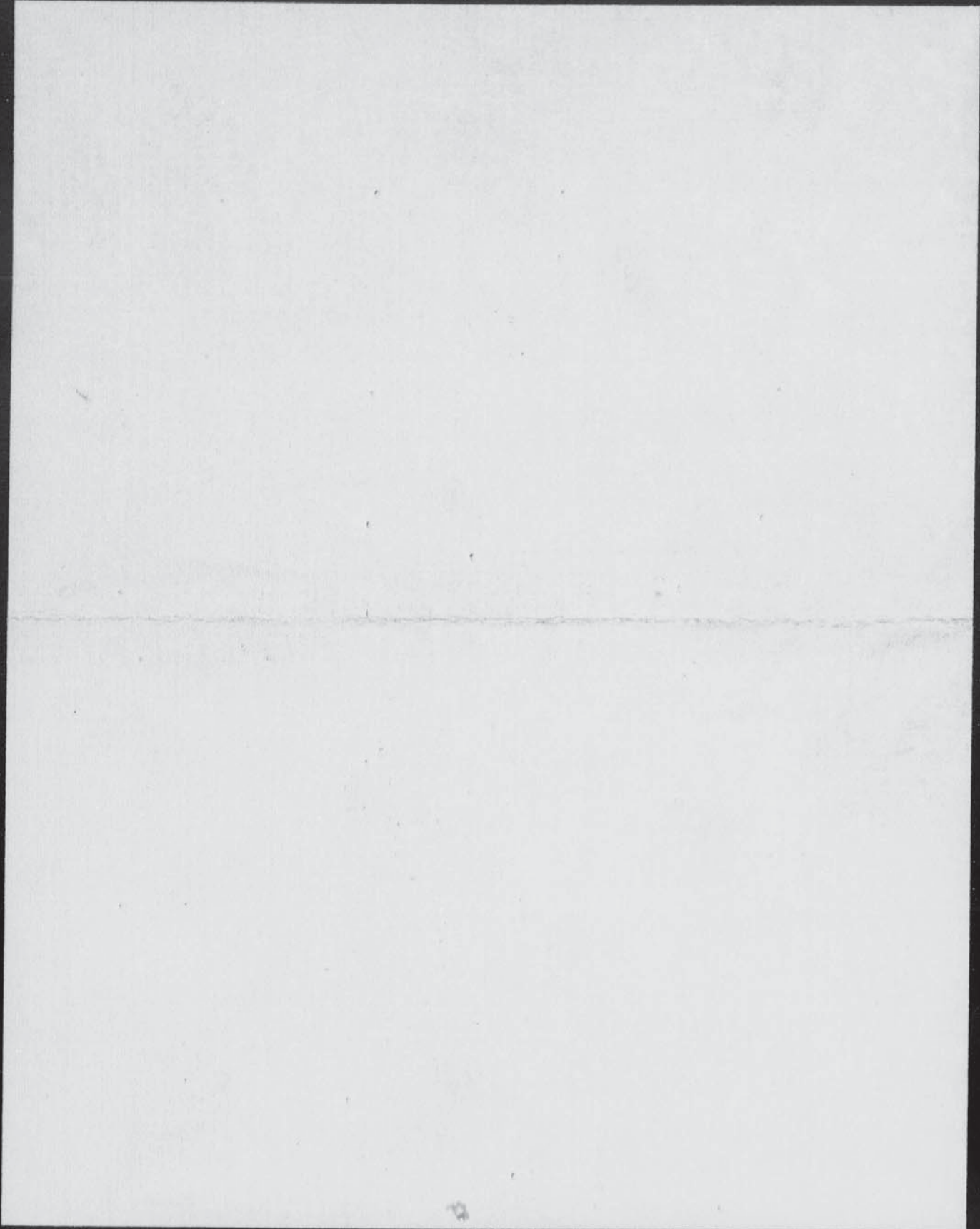
smug and fast in the warm belt!
