to know Jordan better; have  
met him many times but  
only for a few minutes.  
Markham I have never met  
he is another man I want  
to know. His "Lincoln & other  
poems" I should like to read  
after reading your appreciative  
account of his work. I'll  
have much to enquire  
about his aims & methods  
when you come.
