Dear Mr Johnson.

I've been in the Sierra & Cascade mountains most of the summer & have not yet got my note books about me yet therefore I can't give definite answers to your questions about the Forest Reservations. Will try to in a few days after a short visit I'm about to make to my daughter on the Mohave Desert.

I've been crying "Save the Forests" for at least 30 years, but most of the work actually accomplished was done under your suggestions or guidance after 1890.

As to the H. Hitchy the Supervisors have decided to have a vote taken on the question of \$750,000 - to purchase land & rights required, I enclose a few clippings. Mr Colby has been watching every movement while I was away. He can give you more complete information I'll take your advice on the case letters, & am ever faithfully yours John Muir
