To the City of San Francisco, holder of a permit authorizing it, under certain circumstances, to occupy and use for municipal water supply purposes lands of the United States in the Hetch Hetchy Valley in the Yosemite National Park, California, and to all Persons, Associations, and Corporations appearing on the files of the Department of the Interior as objectors to said permit:

You, and each of you, are hereby notified that the oral argument in the aforesaid matter, which was heretofore set to be made before the Secretary of the Interior at his office in Washington, D. C., on November 20 at 10:30 A.M., has been postponed one week and will be held on November 27, 1912, at the said place and hour.
