also. to do so I must have a piece of Ground  
to put the pump plant on, & not to cut up the  
ground for park. I thought to take that triangle  
North of road & West of Port Sts which is  
back of Buill's place. I am in hopes yet  
to make a success of the water business,  
will you sell it to me for that purpose.  
(Or I will have no objection whatever for  
you to make out a Deed and give it to me.)  
as it is only for that purpose that I want it.
