Open Education Resources (OER)

The high cost of course materials is a significant barrier to many students graduating in a timely manner and succeeding academically.

OER are free and openly licensed educational materials – including full courses, textbooks, streaming videos, and other materials – that can be used to support teaching.

Adopting OER provides faculty with increased control and ability to customize their curriculum, and reduces textbook costs for students.

Faculty Course Development Initiative

Faculty can apply for a \$2500 stipend to support their curriculum development work in Summer 2018. The requirements for participation are:

1. Commit to adopting, modifying, or creating new OER materials for use in your course. CTL and Library staff will be available to assist you throughout this process.
2. Attend a half-day orientation workshop in early Summer 2018, and work with CTL and Library staff to create a realistic implementation and assessment plan.
3. Submit periodic brief progress reports.
4. Teach your enhanced course, with significant OER adoption or creation, in Fall 2018 or Spring 2019.
5. Implement your course assessment plan.
6. Share your experiences with the campus community and consider mentoring future faculty.
